

# Directions to Camp Clyde M. York 4-H Center Crossville, TN

## From Birmingham, AL:

- Take I-59 N toward Gadsden. (From I-459, travel 123 miles).
- Take the Left ramp to I-24 West toward Nashville and travel 13 miles.
- Take Exit 155 (Jasper/Dunlap) and turn RIGHT onto TN-28 N. Proceed 70 miles, merging with US-127 in Dunlap.
- Turn LEFT onto Pigeon Ridge Rd/ Hwy 419 (the entrance to Cumberland Mtn. State Park) and proceed 4 miles.
- Turn LEFT onto Lantana Rd/TN-101, proceed 1.5 miles.
- Turn RIGHT onto Taylors Chapel Rd, proceed 2.5 miles.
- Turn RIGHT onto POW Camp Rd.
- Take the second RIGHT at the Clyde M. York Center sign.

## From Chattanooga, TN:

- From I-24, take Exit 178 onto US-27 N toward Dayton and proceed 23 miles.
- At Soddy Daisy, take the LEFT fork onto TN-111 and proceed 17 miles.
- Exit at US-127/TN-8 and turn RIGHT onto US-127. Proceed 41.5 miles.
- Turn LEFT onto Pigeon Ridge Rd/ Hwy 419 (the entrance to Cumberland Mtn. State Park) and proceed 4 miles.
- Turn LEFT onto Lantana Rd/TN-101, proceed 1.6 miles.
- Turn RIGHT onto Taylors Chapel Rd, proceed 2.7 miles.
- Turn RIGHT onto POW Camp Rd.
- Take the second RIGHT at the Clyde M. York Center sign.

## From Nashville, TN:

- Take I-40 East toward Knoxville/Huntsville.
- Take Exit 317-US-127 toward Crossville.
- Turn RIGHT onto US-127 S.
- Proceed 3 miles and turn RIGHT at the 5<sup>th</sup> signal light onto US-70 N.
- At the next signal stay straight and proceed on US-70 (4.5 miles).
- Turn LEFT onto POW Camp Rd (look for a University of Tennessee sign on the left and a Pomona Gas Station on the right) and proceed 3 miles.
- Turn LEFT at the Clyde M. York Center sign.

## From Knoxville, TN:

- Take I-40 West toward Nashville.
- Take Exit 322-Peavine Rd/TN-101 toward Crossville.
- Turn LEFT onto TN-101.
- Proceed .4 mile and turn RIGHT onto US-70 N/TN-101.
- Proceed on US-70 approximately 6.4 miles (it will become Lantana Rd).
- Turn RIGHT onto Taylors Chapel Rd, proceed 2.7 miles.
- Turn RIGHT onto POW Camp Rd.
- Take the second RIGHT at the Clyde M. York Center sign.
