As a PASSPORTkids! chaperone, you are extremely important to us! We recognize the sacrifice you make to help provide a positive summer ministry experience for the children of your church. One of the perks of bringing your group to PASSPORTkids! is that we take care of the programming. Adults who have run their own camp programs often remark about the pleasant surprise of coming to PASSPORTkids! without the stress of having to “be in charge” all the time. Your primary role is to supervise your group at night and during Free Time and meals.

On the flip side, we could not do camp without you! We depend on volunteers to help provide the safety and attention campers need as well as support for the hard-working staff. The jobs are simple, and we will give you the instructions you need. **You can read a brief overview of the volunteer positions in the box on the right.**

As you can see, there are plenty of opportunities to make the most of the camp experience. You will be asked to volunteer after you arrive at camp. The only position we require churches to fill prior to camp is that of Bible Study Assistant. In order to have a sufficient number (one for each of our Bible Study Groups), we ask all churches to recruit one Bible Study Assistant for every 10 campers you are bringing. Churches bringing fewer than 10 campers are not required to provide a Bible Study Assistant.

We are grateful for your help and are glad to do the bulk of the work so that you can do the most important job—being the caring face and hands of Jesus Christ for the campers you bring. We hope you will sense our appreciation as we seek to minister to you, too!

## Welcome to the Daily Grind!

The Daily Grind is one of our ways to thank all our adult chaperones for the important part you play in the camp experience and in the campers' lives. It is designed to give you the information you need for the day, as well as time to relax, sip some coffee, and mingle with other adults and the PASSPORTkids! Program Staff. Daily Grind is followed by Adult Bible Study, which will give you a taste of what the campers are learning but is written specifically for adults, with lots of room for discussion.

## Adult Chaperones

### BIBLE STUDY ASSISTANT:

assigned to help one Bible Study Group during Bible Study for the entire camp session.

### RECREATION ASSISTANT:

assists the Rec Coordinator with morning recreation games.

### MISSIONS ACTIVITY ASSISTANT:

assists the staff leader for one afternoon in one of the missions activities.

### CAMPER'S CHOICE ASSISTANT:

assists the staff leader of an interest group (such as drama, soccer, canoeing, etc.) for one afternoon.

### SIXTH SENSE ASSISTANT:

assists the Pastor with a special activity for Sixth Graders one day.

### REC PARTY ASSISTANT:

helps with setup, monitoring, scoring, and cleanup of this Night 1 event.

### NIGHT MARKET ASSISTANT:

assists with games and activities during this Night 2 party, which simulates the culture of our global focus people.
